

Week 2: Outpouring

Share that you'll be praying today for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the lost in Turkey.

Testimony & Praise: 15 min

Begin your time by each sharing brief testimonies of how you have seen God at work in or around you recently. After everyone has shared, let these testimonies lead you into prayers of thanksgiving and praise, thanking God for who He is and what He does.

“I will pour out my Spirit”: 10 min

*‘In the last days,’ God says,
‘I will pour out my Spirit upon all people.
Your sons and daughters will prophesy.
Your young men will see visions,
and your old men will dream dreams.
In those days I will pour out my Spirit
even on my servants—men and women alike—
and they will prophesy.
Acts 2:17-18*

After reading this passage through twice, spend time thanking God for these promises He made in His Word. Then, declare and pray these verses over the people of Turkey, asking for an outpouring of His Spirit that would touch every generation, young and old.

“All people”: 15 min

As a group, spend 2 minutes in silence, asking God to highlight a specific group of people in Turkey that He would have you pray for. This could be a people group, an age group, people with a certain occupation, etc. After the two minutes are over, take turns praying that God would pour out His Spirit on the group of people He highlighted to you. Continue praying over groups in Turkey as God brings people to mind.

“Desperate”: 10 min

Share an image of dry, cracked soil. As you look at the photo together, pray that the people of Turkey would wake up to see how much they need Jesus. Pray that self-sufficiency and pride would be broken down, and that instead the people of Turkey would begin to desperately seek out the Truth. Pray that they would begin to hunger and thirst for God like never before (Psalm 63:1).



Song & Thanksgiving: 10 min
