

Week 3: Witness

Share that you'll be praying today for the Word to spread across Turkey as bold witnesses are sent out.

Prayers of Praise: 10 min

Silently reflect back on who first shared with you and any generations of faith in your biological or church family. As a group, spend time praising God for those people and their witness in your life.

Praying Acts 13:2-3 over believers in Turkey: 15 min

While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off. Acts 13:2-3.

As you read and reflect on this verse, thank God for all the believers in Turkey who have giftings like Barnabas and Saul. Pray they would be released in the same way and allow God to use them mightily. At the end, have everyone raise their hands symbolically laying their hands on believers in Turkey. Pray short prayers of blessing and commissioning.

Song of Intercession: 7 min

As you listen or sing along to this song, agree with it on behalf of believers in Turkey.

Hindrances: 10 min

Spend two minutes in silence as a group asking God if there is anything standing in the way of the Word spreading across Turkey. As you listen you may sense God speak to you through a verse, a word, a picture, etc. Take time to pray into these things God has shown you asking that nothing would hinder His Word going forth.

Praying Acts 19:10 over Turkey: 10 min

This went on for two years so that all the Jews and Greeks who lived in the province of Asia heard the word of the Lord. Acts 19:10

Take a few minutes to praise God that this happened in Turkey during the 1st century AD and 15 million people heard. After that, ask God to do it again for the 83 million people who live in Turkey today.

Thanksgiving: 5 min

Praise God that during the month of Ramadan people *are* seeking Him and there is increased spiritual activity, even among nominal Muslims. Praise God for the ways He's revealing Himself through dreams and visions during this time, and thank Him in advance for those who will respond to the revelation.
